3 SUPERLATIVE DEGREE
used to compare three or more things

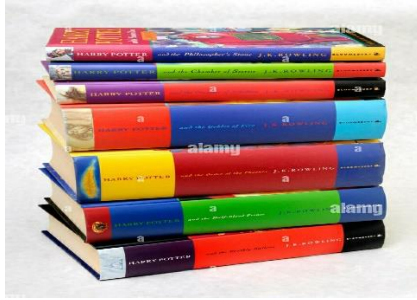
